UNM-Southwest Hispanic Research Institute (SHRI) 2019-2020 Supplemental Funding Awards for Research and Conference Presentation

Application Deadline: Nov. 15, 2019 by 5 p.m. Award Notifications: Dec. 11, 2019 by 5 p.m.

Criteria

Project Proposals must meet or reflect SHRI's Mission and Program Goals funding criteria: "Established in 1980, the Southwest Hispanic Research Institute (SHRI) promotes multidisciplinary research on the Latino/Hispanic populations of New Mexico and the United States." (https://shri.unm.edu/)

Eligibility

- 1. SHRI Research Faculty Associates
- 2. Currently Enrolled UNM Graduate Students (Endorsed by a SHRI member):

Restrictions

- 1. Awards will not exceed \$1,000.00
- 2. Awards can only be used to fund approved expenditure costs. They cannot fund salaries, stipends, GA-RA lines, projects leading to the generation of student credit hours, or contract-based data collection. Unfortunately, awards also cannot fund the purchasing of equipment (computers, digital cameras, or other devices, for example). Awards can only fund costs incurred between the award date and May 30, 2020.

Award Categories: Research Projects and Conference Presentation

1. For research project awards, applicants must provide:

- a. Current CV and unofficial transcripts (for student applicants);
- b. 250-500-word (maximum) narrative description of research project. Written for non-specialists, the narrative should provide an overview of the research project and explain how SHRI supplemental funding will facilitate the completion of the project or launch the research project;
- c. Timeline of tasks toward completion of the project;
- d. Statement about the research project's dissemination, plans for publication, or use for seed funding for further research. (Book, article, chapter, thesis, grant project);
- e. Budget and Justification, including status of other sources of funding; and
- f. For students, the application packet must be reviewed and signed by a SHRI faculty member.

2. For conference presentation awards, applicants must provide:

- a. Current CV and unofficial transcripts (for student applicants);
- b. 250-500-word (maximum) narrative description of the research to be presented and its relation to the presenter's current or new scholarship;
- c. Proof of conference participation (program, poster/abstract acceptance, conference website indicating applicant's professional role at the conference);
- c. Budget and Justification, including status of other sources of funding; and
- d. For students, the application packet must be reviewed and signed by a SHRI faculty member.

PLEASE NOTE: Funding is reserved for applicants presenting scholarly work either as a speaker, poster presentation, or delivery of a conference paper. Costs to attend as a panel moderator or an audience member do not qualify.

Award Requirements: All awardees must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Expectation of sharing final work to be featured in either SHRI's website, archives, publications, and/or public events;
- 2. Submission of 250-word end-of award WRITE-UP of Final Accomplishments (to be included in SHRI's Annual Reports);
- 3. Acknowledgement of SHRI in publication of the funded research project, public presentation, conference paper or poster presentation (including digital media); and
- 4. Demonstrated effort to secure other sources of financial support.
- 5. Present on the advances of their research either at a one-time symposium or at a brown bag presentations to SHRI affiliates and partners during the 2019-2020 academic.

Submission Instructions

- 1. Complete the Application Cover Sheet and provide all materials requested on Check List. Only those candidates who have submitted full application packages containing all documents listed above will be considered for award selection;
